

## **Cultural linguistic clinical connection infographic assignment: Grading Rubric**

Identifies AAE features in transcripts (20%)

- All features are identified (missed <2 features)
- Most features are identified (missed 2 – 4 features)
- Missing most features (missed >4 features)

Defines AAE and MAE (10%).

- Clear and succinct definitions of AAE and MAE are provided.
- Provides definitions for both AAE and MAE but some detail, clarity or might be unnecessarily lengthy.
- Missing a definition and/or direct quotations are used. Definitions are unclear and lack detail.

Provides facts and myths about AAE (25%).

- Provides at least 2 facts about AAE and 2 misconceptions in detail with examples and evidence provided to support data presented;
- Provides at least one fact and misconception; may lack some detail or missing examples or evidence
- Provides only facts or only misconceptions; absence of detail, examples and/or evidence is noted

Gives examples of AAE (15%).

- Includes at several examples (at least 3 grammatical and 2 phonological) of features of AAE that are accurate and illustrate differences from MAE
- Includes fewer than five examples or examples; may contain a single error
- Includes only grammatical or phonological examples; multiple errors in examples are present

Describes ASHA's position statement on dialects (5%).

- ASHA's position statement is summarized clearly and succinctly using your own words and no direct quotes
- ASHA's position statement is summarized but may be tangential or lack clarity; no direct quotes
- ASHA's position statement is directly quoted

Summarizes the importance of the information (15%)

- Summary is insightful and clinically meaningful
- Summary demonstrates some insight into the importance but may lack robust insight
- Summary lack insight and fails to describe the importance of this information

Infographic includes appropriate references, citations, and is typo-free (10%).

- Infographic includes all required references from approved resources; in-text citations used consistently, document is typo-free
- Infographic includes all request references but may include one unapproved resource; in-text citations are used consistently; document has fewer than 2 typos
- Infographic missing references and/or in-text citations; has greater than 2 typos
