Language Sample of 3-year-old male

Collection Procedure: Play

Comments: Only 25 child utterances collected, will finish collecting during next session

E: What would you like for a snack?

C: I want cookie.

E: Maybe later.

E: How about some fruit?

C: Um can I have it now?

E: What did Mommy say earlier?

C: Mommy say no.

C: But I hungry!

E: Let's find something healthy to eat.

C: Look at my toys.

E: What toys do you have?

C: I have lots of cars.

C: This one is red.

E: That's right!

E: What other colors do you see?

C: Um that one is blue.

C: I likes the green one best.

E: The green one is nice. What does it do?

C: It goes fast.

C: Vroom vroom!

E: What else do you want to play with?

C: Uh where's my teddy?

C: I can't find him.

E: Let's look around.

E: Where did you last see him?

C: Oh, there he is!

C: He's under the table.

E: Good job finding him!

E: What should we do now?

C: I um I want to play outside.

C: Can we go to the park?

E: That sounds like a great idea.

E: What do you like to do at the park?

C: I likes the swings.

C: Push me higher!

E: Okay, but be careful.

E: How does it feel?

C: I'm flying like a bird.
